The master's program in Health Management aims to provide students with an interdisciplinary perspective in areas such as health economics, health care finance, health policies, health law, health communication. In addition, by enriching the theoretical knowledge acquired at the undergraduate level with more comprehensive education methods, it is aimed to train specialists needed in the field of health management. With the health management graduate program, students will also gain academic qualifications that will contribute to the literature. The main objectives of the program are to equip students who graduate from the master's program with the skills to solve problems with scientific methods taking into account the developments and needs in the field of health management and contribute to scientific research.
